### **Annual Academic Scholarship Program**

This scholarship program is maintained and operated by The Logistics Council – Milwaukee Roundtable. The organization is a not-for-profit association of supply chain professionals who live and work in the greater Milwaukee area and surrounding communities. The Logistics Council is a chapter of Delta Nu Alpha, an international transportation and logistics fraternity.

The Logistics Council will award up to \$10,000 in scholarships for the 2019-2020 academic year. Individual scholarship awards can range from \$500 to \$3,000.

#### **Qualifications of Candidates**

1. The candidate must be an accepted registered college/university student in the state of Wisconsin. Strong preference will be given to students in supply chain, logistics, operations, and production management areas of study.
2. The candidate must be pursuing an associates degree, undergraduate degree, or graduate degree.
3. The candidate must be continuing their college/university education in the next fall semester when the award would be provided to them (Fall 2019)
4. Candidates who wish to be considered for the scholarship must submit a completed application by the July 9<sup>th</sup> deadline with awards announced by August 15<sup>th</sup> and funds distributed during our September 2019 program event.
5. The Logistics Council does not and will not discriminate against any candidate who has met the qualifications for the scholarship and properly completed the application prior to the deadline.

#### **Selection of Candidates**

1. The scholarship committee of The Logistics Council will review the submissions and make the final decisions on awards on or before August 15<sup>th</sup>, 2019.
2. The following factors shall be primary considerations for awards:
  - Academic scholarship
  - Involvement and participation in outside activities/interests
  - Potential for success in a business profession, preferably in supply chain or logistics
  - Letter of reference from faculty member, employer, or mentor

2. Up-to-Date Resume – you must provide us with an updated resume listing your education and work experiences.
3. Letter of Reference – you must obtain one (1) signed letter of reference from a trusted faculty member, employer, or mentor who can support you as a solid candidate for this scholarship.
